

MARKETRON CONFIGURATION

ENTER 'Y' IF USING MULTIPLE STATION FILE NAMES: When using more than one database in Marketron it can be assumed that Multiple station file names will be used. The format for these files will be MMDDYS (Where S is the station number) standard file names are in the MMDDYY format.

STRIP LEADING ZERO'S FROM CART NUMBERS: Should Power-link remove any leading zeros from the cart numbers during the conversion process

PROMPT ON UNASSIGNED CART NUMBERS: Must Power-Link look for and prompt the user when a commercial has no assigned cart number. Most installations require this setting to be turned to 'Y'.

PASS EMPTY CART NUMBERS WITHOUT STOPPING: Should Power-Link pass events without cart numbers (blank cart numbers) without prompting the user.

ENTER 'Y' IF USING MILITARY TIME IN #12 TYPE LOGS: Will the #12 type files have military time or civilian time.

PASS PROGRAM ITEMS WITHOUT CART NUMBERS: When converting the file should Power-Link convert program items even if they have no cart numbers.

INCLUDE RETURN FILES TO MARKETRON IN CLEANUP: When deleting old files should Power-link, delete the files returned to Marketron for Post log functions.

UPDATE AIRTIMES ON NORMAL AIRED EVENTS ALSO: When reporting back the time of a played event must Marketron update all times to the actual airtime even if the airtime is within the allowed play window as configured in program configuration. IE if an event is scheduled at 10:05:00 and plays at 10:06:00 must Marketron be told to update this event's airtime or just accept that it played normally at its scheduled time?

STRIP MATERIAL CODES FROM CART? Should PL look for the following Material Codes and strip them from the cart numbers during the conversion process?

CODES TO STRIP: Enter up to 3 different single letter codes to be stripped from cart numbers. These letters usually show up in front of the cart number due to the "Show on Log As" parameter in Marketron.
